Santa Cruz Veterinarian Receives UC Davis School of Veterinary Medicine Fellowship

Judy Force, DVM, owner of Dentistry for Animals in Santa Cruz, has received the 2006 Donald G. Low-California Veterinary Medical Association Practitioner Fellowship at the UC Davis School of Veterinary Medicine.

Dr. Force, one of eight fellowship recipients, will join faculty, residents and students as they conduct rounds, diagnose illnesses and recommend therapies for complex clinical cases at the Veterinary Medical Teaching Hospital.

Practitioners apply for fellowships to improve their knowledge in a particular area of professional interest. Dr. Force, a 1986 graduate of UC Davis School of Veterinary Medicine, will spend 20 days in total with the Anesthesia service.

Donald J Klingborg, associate dean for Public Programs, states, "These fellowships offer a valuable exchange between private practitioners and school faculty. Fellows gain exposure to the newest treatments - many developed at our school. Faculty learn more about trends in today's private practices. Finally, students welcome the practical insights of experienced practitioners."

The Donald G. Low-California Veterinary Medical Association Practitioner Fellowship honors the late Dr. Donald G. Low, former director of the Veterinary Medical Teaching Hospital, where faculty treat 32,000 animal patients each year as they teach essential clinical skills to veterinary students and train residents in more than 30 specialties.
