Notice to Exhibitors

- UNSIGNED OR INCOMPLETE ENTRIES cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 per first entry and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Postdated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- ENTRY FEES will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, extreme weather conditions (including, but not limited to, extreme heat, snow-storms or hurricanes) or any other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the Trial, no refund of entry fee will be made. Refunds for bitches in season will be given less \$10.00 for administrative fees. Written notice must be given to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes before judging starts.
- ACKNOWLEDGEMENT of entries will be made as soon as possible after the closing date. Should such acknowledgement not be received by an exhibitor within 7 days prior to the Trial, please notify the Trial Secretary.
- CLASS TRANSFERS (Move-Ups) to the next level class are permitted in accordance with AKC regulations.
