It's not too soon to start gathering info about the titles your dog earned from Nov.1, 2023 - Oct.31, 2024.





Certificates and logo ornaments commemorate the Most Improved Dog & Handler and Good Sportsmanship, which are voted on by the membership, and the President's Award and Board Appreciation for exceptional contributions and/or long-term volunteer service. We will be asking in a separate survey to nominate a dog/handler team that you feel has made big improvements this past year, and to submit a name of a member whom you feel consistently demonstrates good sportsmanship.



Also, there are several perpetual award plaques to recognize particularly difficult achievements, such as the UDX, OTCH, perfect 200 score in regular obedience, High Combined in Open and Utility, and more. Refer to your MBDTC Policy Handbook for a complete list.


## MEMBER BRAGS
